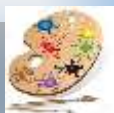

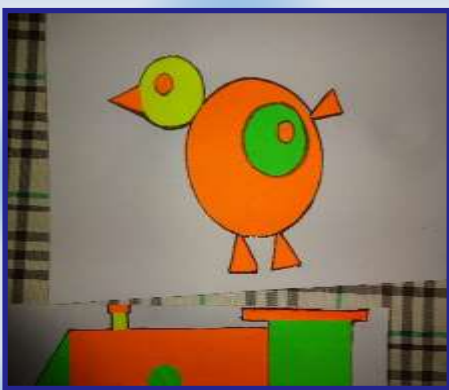


15. Creativity

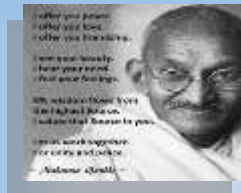


22. International Peace Day

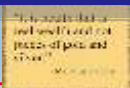


International peace day was observed on 21st September 2019.
